Presentation of CONSUEL



- 21 juillet 1964: setting up of CONSUEL.
- CONSUEL: 46 years of expertise in safety of electrical installations.
- 14 December 1972: decree making compulsory a written attestation of conformity issued by an agreed body before the connexion.
- 2001: modification of the 1972 decree, with its extension in case of total renovation

National Electrical Safety Observatory

16 November 1995: birth of ONSE

Organisation/advantages:

1. Informal,
2. Composed by : all players of the industry (utilities, manufacturers, wholesalers, contractors), plus ministries, consumers, insurance companies, firemen.
3. Flexible, no By Laws, no fee

National Electrical Safety Observatory

An Observatory, why ?

1. Not any organisation can take pride of alone holding the truth, nobody alone can be credible
2. Information is not easy to collect
3. To share and exchange between players of the industry
4. In reason of the representativity of such a structure.

National Electrical Safety Observatory

Its activities ?

Observe, set a survey and reliable statistics

1. Make recommendations to public authorities in order to
 - *** legislate
 - *** improve the existing legislation
3. Make recommendations to partners in the industry
4. Be the reference, enable the industry to progress
5. Provide information to FISUEL

National Electrical Safety Observatory

How does it work ?

1. Setting up working groups
2. Holding an annual plenary meeting
3. Bringing out shared conclusions for making recommendations and argumentations
4. Organising press conferences and communicating



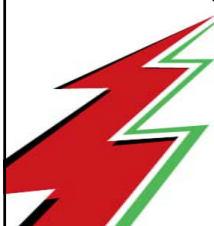

2. Legislative developments
3. Non compliances analysis
4. Knowledge of what is done in other countries
5. Monitoring dangerous, non compliant products

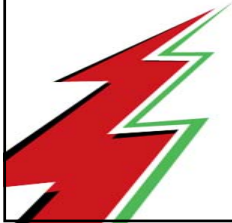


National Electrical Safety Observatory
